Peddy Paper Intercultural

1. Framing	<p>As part of the Interculturality Festival 2025, Peddy Paper Intercultural aims to be a dynamic and participatory activity that promotes knowledge, interaction, and appreciation of different cultures. Through a journey featuring challenges, games, and questions about traditions, languages, cuisine, and curiosities of various cultures, participants are invited to learn, share experiences, and discover the rich cultural diversity that characterizes the local community.</p> <p>This initiative aims, in a playful and inclusive way, to raise awareness of the values of respect for differences, intercultural dialogue, and the construction of a more cohesive and pluralistic society, in line with the festival's objectives.</p>
2. Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Promote knowledge and appreciation of cultural diversity. ▪ Encourage interaction, fellowship, and team spirit among participants of different backgrounds. ▪ Raise awareness of respect for differences and intercultural dialogue in a playful and inclusive way. ▪ Encourage participatory learning through games, questions, and challenges related to traditions, languages, gastronomy, and cultural curiosities. ▪ Contribute to building a more cohesive, plural, and supportive community, in line with the objectives of the Interculturality Festival.
3. Organizing Entity	<p>The “Peddy Paper Intercultural” activity is promoted and organized by the Aveiro City Council, through the Social Action Division, within the scope of the Aveiro+ CLDS 5G Project, in close partnership with CLAIM/Casa Vera Cruz.</p>
4. Recipients	<p>National and international citizens who want to learn more about the city of Aveiro and its diverse cultures.</p> <p>Children and young people are welcome to participate, provided they are accompanied by an adult.</p>

6. Number of vacancies	<p>10 Teams of 1 to 3 members.</p>
7. 8. Registration conditions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Mandatory completion of the registration form with the data of all participants of each Team for insurance and registration purposes in the activity, complying with the legislation in force regarding the protection of personal data (requested data: Name, Gender, Date of Birth, Marital Status, Identification Document No., NIF, NISS, Address, Telephone Contact, Education, Employment Status).
9. Team	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Each team must have a name of its own choosing.
10. Admission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Applications will be accepted in accordance with sections 4, 7, and 8 of these Participation Rules, taking into account the order in which applications are received and the number of available spaces; ▪ When the number of spaces is reached, the next candidates will be placed on a waiting list, maintaining the order of application; ▪ Withdrawals must be communicated in writing within 24 hours of confirmation of admission. In the event of withdrawal, the space will automatically be assigned to the first group on the waiting list.
11. Routes and Tests	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The Peddy Paper consists of 13 stations located in the city center of Aveiro, along a continuous and accessible route. Each team will be given a "Pedestrian Map of Aveiro - Center" to assist with completing the route. ▪ Each team has two hours to complete the route and must arrive at the Manuel Firmino Market, the final station, by 5:00 PM, or they will be disqualified. ▪ Each station corresponds to a challenge, which will be assigned a specific score (see point 15). ▪ From 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM, the organization will validate the responses and assign the final score. ▪ The awards ceremony will take place at 6:15 PM at the Manuel Firmino Market.
12. Rules of participation	<p><u>WHAT IS ALLOWED:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All team members must remain together throughout the route; ▪ At each checkpoint, the team must take a group photo as proof of their visit; ▪ All participants must comply with road safety and traffic regulations; ▪ Teams may enlist the help of community members to identify the location of checkpoints, rather than obtaining information through digital means. <p><u>IT IS NOT PERMITTED:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Changing participants between teams after the start of the activity; ▪ Using means of transportation (bicycles, cars, scooters, etc.); ▪ Damaging, destroying, or removing any material used in the events.
13. Safety Rules	<p>The event takes place in a public/private space, and individual safety is the responsibility of each participant.</p>
14. Jury	<p>The evaluation of the tests will be carried out by a Jury Team, which will include members of the CMA and CLAIM, appointed by the organization.</p>
15. Scoring and Classification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Each race will be scored according to the provisions of Annex 1. ▪ The final classification will be the sum of correct answers + total time spent + penalties (when applicable). ▪ In the event of a tie, the team with the most correct answers will have the advantage and, ultimately, the team that completed the course in the shortest time.

16. Penalties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Late submission of the test (after 5 p.m.): disqualification. Unsportsmanlike behavior: immediate disqualification.
17. Awards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All participating teams will receive a tote bag containing a notebook, pencil, hat, and one bottle of water per participant. The top three teams will receive symbolic prizes, which will be presented at 6:15 PM at the Manuel Firmino Market.

17. Duties and rights of the Organizing entity	<p>The Organizing Entity's Duties are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To obtain personal accident insurance for participants, in accordance with current legislation, for the period limited to Peddy Paper's opening hours; To provide a snack to each participant; To comply with current legislation regarding the protection of personal data. <p>The Organizing Entity has the following rights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Refuse participation of any participant who fails to comply with the rules of participation or who displays behavior inappropriate to the spirit of the event; Interrupt or cancel the participation of any participant who fails to respect safety or the organization, or who disrupts the normal functioning of the event; Collect and use images or videos captured during the Peddy Paper for institutional outreach and event promotion purposes, safeguarding personal data protection rights.
18. Duties and rights of participants	<p>The following are the Participants' Duties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Comply with the Participation Rules and any instructions provided by the Organizing Entities; Appear with the Event Organization Team at the scheduled time indicated in point 5; Respect the opening hours stipulated by the Organization; Comply with all safety regulations described; Cover any expenses arising from the activation of emergency medical services that are not covered by the Personal Accident Insurance policy of which you are aware. <p>Participants' Rights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participation insurance;
19. Procedure in case of Accident or Illness	In the event of an accident, you must contact 112 and the Organization immediately.
20. Assessment	The Organization will provide participants with a satisfaction/event evaluation questionnaire to collect suggestions and improve future editions.
